Our 2,000 s.f. gallery space presents over a half dozen shows annually. We are proud to provide artists the opportunity to exhibit and sell their work in a professional manner and we offer a very reasonable consignment deal to exhibiting artists.

Our website—www.621N4TH.com—allows us to branch out and market to a global audience for collectible and functional items such as artists books, limited editions, publications, clothing, accessories, etc. We select a majority of the work for our gallery on consignment basis. Artists that sell their work in our physical location also benefit from additional exposure on our ecommerce site and publishing partnerships.

Submitting to 621N4TH

621N4TH has developed specific criteria to ensure that the quality and marketability of the work offered for sale maintain a consistent standard that will benefit the buyer, seller and artist. We are seeking a variety of contemporary artwork, both collectible and functional, to sell on a consignment basis.

621N4TH will accept or decline work to the gallery based on the following criteria:

- Design must show aesthetic individuality, compositional quality and reflect a unified body of work
- Craftsmanship must show capability beyond minimal technical skills and experience with materials, tools of the medium and their function
- Items should be priced at a realistic ratio between the value of time and materials to the artist, and the value of the artwork to the customer

The following types of work are NOT eligible for retail sale:

- Works executed from commercial patterns, molds, stencils or kits of any description
- Crafts made of consumable materials such as food preserves

Required for submission:

- 7 to 15 images on cd (300 dpi jpgs), high quality printed images (5x7 or larger), or professional website representing artist's current work
- Number each image / photo and include artist's Last and First name — ex. "1.Walsak.Dennis.jpg"
- Include a retail price list that corresponds to the name of artist's images. Include any variations of the product including color, size, weight, materials used and the quantity available
- An artist resumé
- Signed Loan Agreement Form (attached)
- A shipping envelope with postage for submission items that you wish to be returned
- An artist statement describing the techniques used in the creation of artist's work and the ideas or concepts that you want to communicate to retail gallery clientele

Although submissions may meet all of the criteria at an acceptable level, 621N4TH reserves the right to refuse work based on suitability to the atmosphere of the retail gallery space, the number of artists we have working in the submitted medium and available space. Artists may continue to submit to 621N4TH as new bodies of work are created, as these will be considered separately from any original refused submissions.
